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	 T. Kucera highlighted the real situation in the Arrival Hall T1 (passport control and arrival belts) in S19, referring to a waiting time of up to 60 minutes in order to continue through passport control. This has a significant impact on the passenger experience and baggage delivery (because no one removes baggage from the carousel and it gets full.). There is also a financial impact at the end, as different service providers are obliged to wait for the arrival of passengers and crew for a longer period - applying waiting fees. T. Kucera proposed a revision of the coordination criteria for passport control on arrival, which, however, was rejected. As result T. Kucera at least requested Prague airport to pay maximum attention to the area and passenger comfort via assistance of Red team, information screens and cooperation with the border police. 	T.Kucera
